New Hampshire Ave (Sd 1101 S. Vermont Ave.). To be used to serve neighborhood' telecommunication needs, including DSL service. Possible committee action to approve or request additional information
4. **Discussion of Project on 2005 West Pico Blvd**—Permit approved to *demolish* all existing improvements and develop a two-story, 30,300 square foot headquarters with 161 on-site subterranean parking spaces to serve the Laborers Union Local 300.
5. **Public Comments-** Comments from the public on non-agenda items within the committee's subject matter jurisdiction. Public comments are limited to two minutes per person.
6. **Committee Member Comments** - Comments from the committee members on subject matters within the committee's jurisdiction.
